Re: Code of Conduct Sanctions

Pursuant to our conversation in your due process meeting, you waived your rights to a formal hearing and accepted responsibility for violating the Georgia State University Student Code of Conduct (the "Code"):

III. General Conduct Policies and Procedures

- A. Prohibited General Conduct
 - Verbally threatening, physically abusing, or threatening physical abuse, intimidation, coercion and/or conduct which threatens or endangers the health or safety of self, other students, other members of the University community or campus visitors.

Specifically, on March 15, 2013, you forcefully pulled Georgia State University student, from the car. resisted your attempts of pulling arms and legs. You tried to remove about something said to you. was injured during the altercation when fell and dislocated arm. You have admitted responsibility for pulling from the car. However, you stated that you do not know how arm was injured.

Based upon my review of the information related to your case, as well as our discussion during our meeting you are subject to the following disciplinary sanctions:

1. **Disciplinary Probation** -effective immediately, you are placed on disciplinary probation. Your disciplinary probation will end April 28, 2014. Disciplinary probation is defined as, "Removal of the student from good disciplinary standing."

- 2. Educational Sanctions
 - a. By May 10, 2013, you must complete 20 hours of community service.
 - b. Upon completion of your community service sanction, you will have 10 business days to complete the enclosed reflective essay.
- 3. Conflict Resolution-You are required to attend conflict resolution training.

Your Conflict Resolution

training must be completed by April 23, 2013.

Should you choose to appeal these sanctions, you have five business days to submit a written narrative to Dr. Douglass F. Covey, Vice President of Student Affairs, Georgia State University, P O Box 3999 Atlanta, GA 30302-3999 stating your grounds for appeal. Grounds for appeals are limited to new information that was not presented at our meeting, procedural errors, or that the sanctions are disproportionately severe.
