| 12 | WHEREAS, the Student Judicial Board, in its current capacity as the judicial branch of the Student |
| 13 | Government Association, is not representative of the student body of Georgia State University, and, |
| 14 | WHEREAS, the Student Judicial Board currently serves both the SGA and the Office of the Dean of Students |
| 15 | in an official capacity which presents a conflict of interest, and, |
| 16 | WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch of the SGA ought to be appointed democratically or by democratically |
| 17 | elected students, and held accountable to the students, and |

| 19 | THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY-WIDE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT |
| 20 | ASSOCIATION OF GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT |
| 21 | Section 1: Article 7 of the Student Government Association Constitution currently states: |
| 22 | The authority of the judicial branch of the SGA shall be vested in the Student Judicial Board, |
| 23 | hereinafter referred to as the SJB. The SJB will adhere to confidentiality as it pertains to the Federal |
| 24 | Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) regarding all student conduct matters. All procedures, |
| 25 | rules, and regulations pertaining to the student conduct process and operation of the SJB which are |
| 26 | not contained directly herein shall be incorporated in the SJB Bylaws, Student Handbook, the Student |
| 27 | Code of Conduct (the Code) and other University policies. |
| 28 | And if passed by the university wide senate with a 2/3 majority, the text of the proposed changes and the |
| 29 | original text shall be published on a ballot. The proposed amendment(s) shall be presented to the |
| 30 | student body in a referendum no less than fourteen days and no more than twenty-one days after |
| 31 | publication in the student newspaper. A simple majority of at least 51 percent of votes cast must be |
| 32 | affirmative to pass the amendment(s). Copies of the amendment(s) shall be available for review upon |
| 33 | request at each polling location, and for at least seven days prior to the election, in the SGA office to |
| 34 | read: |
| 35 | "The authority of the judicial branch of the SGA shall be vested in the SGA Judiciary, hereinafter |

36 referred to as the Judiciary. All procedures, rules, and regulations pertaining to the operation of the



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- 1 Judiciary which are not contained directly herein shall be incorporated in the SGA Bylaws, Student
- 2 Handbook, the Student Code of Conduct (the Code), and other University policies."
- 3 Section 2: Article 7 section 7.1 shall be added:
- 4 A. The SGA Judiciary shall consist of no more than 5 Justices.
- B. The Student Bar Association, or any other democratically elected body approved by the University Wide Senate (2/3), shall have the power to interview and recommend candidates to be appointed
 by the University-Wide President and confirmed by the University-Wide Senate.
- 8 C. Student Justices confirmed by the University-Wide Senate may serve on the SGA Judiciary for the
 9 entire duration of their enrollment, as defined by the Student Code of Conduct, at Georgia State
 10 University.
- 11 Section 3: This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government
- 12 Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
